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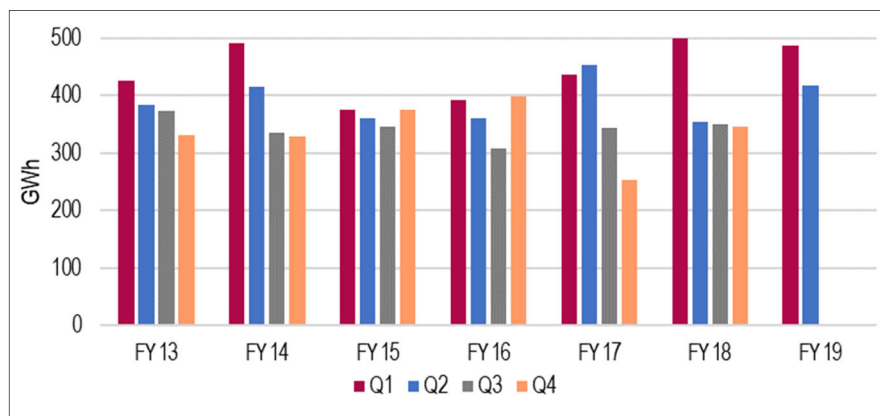
INFIGEN ANNOUNCES SECOND QUARTER FY19 PRODUCTION AND REVENUE

Infigen Energy (ASX: IFN) today reports unaudited production generated and sold from Infigen assets, production sold from contracts that have been entered into with the owners of non-Infigen owned assets and revenue for the three months ended 31 December 2018 (Q2 FY19).

Infigen will release its FY19 interim financial results (H1 FY19) on 21 February 2019. Accordingly, the following H1 FY19 production and revenue results remain subject to audit review.
